## **PASTOR'S LETTER**

## Formal Letter of Request to Receive the Sacrament of Confirmation

#### **Q:** Who writes the letter?

A: The letter is written by the person who wishes to receive the sacrament (the candidate). While the parents of the candidate may assist in its preparation, the letter's contents should be the work of the candidate.

## Q: To whom is the letter addressed?

A: The letter is written to the Pastor of St. John's, Father Charles C. Smith (see next page).

#### **O:** What format should the letter take?

A: The letter is a formal document. It should be typed, or neatly handwritten in INK, on plain, unlined paper, or stationary. The confirmandi's name and signature should be affixed to the letter. **DO NOT USE PENCIL. DO NOT USE NOTEBOOK PAPER RIPPED OUT OF A SPIRAL NOTEBOOK.** 

## Q: What should the letter contain?

A: The letter should address the following items:

- 1. The candidate's statement of assurance that he/she feels adequately prepared to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.
- 2. A statement expressing WHY the candidate wishes to receive the sacrament.
- 3. A sentence formally requesting permission to receive the sacrament

## **Q:** When is the letter due?

A: The letter is due **before November 15, 2024**. Letters should be placed in an envelope, labeled "Confirmation", and marked to the attention of Father Smith. Letters should be sent to – or – dropped off at the parish office at the address found at the top of the next page.
