

Parent Policy Agreement

Precepts of the Church

1. To assist at Mass on all Sundays and holydays of obligation.
 - a. Jan. 1 – Solemnity of Mary
 - b. 40 days after Easter – Ascension Thursday
 - c. Aug. 15 – Assumption of Mary
 - d. Nov. 1 – All Saints’ Day
 - e. Dec. 8 – Immaculate Conception
 - f. Dec. 25 – Christmas
2. To fast and abstain on the days appointed.
(The Church’s current regulations in the U.S. require fasting and abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday; and abstinence from meat on the Fridays during Lent. Every Friday is a day of sacrifice.)
3. To confess our sins at least once a year in the sacrament of Penance.
4. To receive Holy Communion worthily during the Easter Season.
(To receive Holy Communion worthily, one must: observe the Eucharistic Fast of one hour before receiving Holy Communion; Be in the state of grace, Believe that Holy Communion is the true Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.)
5. To contribute to the support of the Church.
6. To observe the laws of the Church concerning marriage.

As the parent of a Confirmation Candidate, I promise to fully assist in my child’s preparation for the Sacrament. I assure that my child will continue to study the Catholic Faith and will regularly attend Mass and receive the Sacrament of Penance before and after Confirmation. I will help my child grow in understanding and respect of the Precepts of the Church.
