Precepts of the Church

- 1. To assist at Mass on all Sundays and holydays of obligation.
 - a. Jan. 1 Solemnity of Mary
 - b. 40 days after Easter Ascension Thursday
 - c. Aug. 15 Assumption of Mary
 - d. Nov. 1 All Saints' Day
 - e. Dec. 8 Immaculate Conception
 - f. Dec. 25 Christmas
- 2. To fast and abstain on the days appointed. (The Church's current regulations in the U.S. require fasting and abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday; and abstinence from meat on the Fridays during Lent. Every Friday is a day of sacrifice.)
- **3.** To confess our sins at least once a year in the sacrament of Penance.
- **4.** To receive Holy Communion worthily during the Easter Season. (*To receive Holy Communion worthily, one must: observe the Eucharistic Fast of one hour before receiving Holy Communion; Be in the state of grace, Believe that Holy Communion is the true Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.)*
- **5.** To contribute to the support of the Church.
- 6. To observe the laws of the Church concerning marriage.

As the parent of a Confirmation Candidate, I promise to fully assist in my child's preparation for the Sacrament. I assure that my child will continue to study the Catholic Faith and will regularly attend Mass and receive the Sacrament of Penance before and after Confirmation. I will help my child grow in understanding and respect of the Precepts of the Church.
